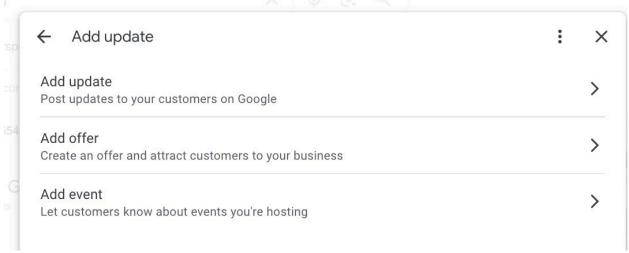
Google Business Profile Marketing Strategy

Here are some best practices for agents looking to optimize their GBP for SEO and lead generation:

Types of Posts (Updates):

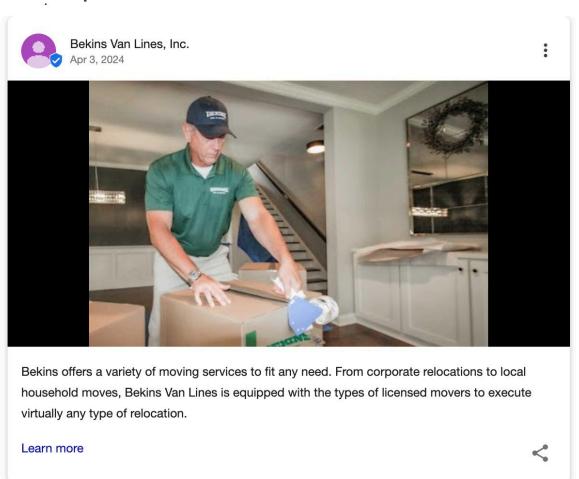


Best Practices for GBP Posts:

- Post Regularly Posts on Google Business Profile will be archived into a section that can be accessed by clicking "view more." Marketing experts recommend posting at least once a month to build up a good archive of information. This will also help your business become a trusted source by both users and search engines. Posting regularly increases the likelihood that a user will visit the profile and click through to the website.
- Keep the post content concise Google allows you to use 1500 characters in your post content, but the ideal length is around 150-300 characters. Not only does this prevent your text from getting cut off in search results, but most users are looking for short bursts of helpful information.

- **Utilize photos and videos -** Make your post pop with a high-resolution photo or video. A branded photo is preferred over stock imagery. Photo guidelines are as follows:
 - Images smaller than 480 x 270 pixels or larger than 2120 x 1192 pixels are not accepted.
 - It's best to choose images with a resolution of 1200 x 900 pixels.
 - Use high-resolution images to ensure a professional appearance.
- Include a call to action Google offers a number of buttons to include in your post such as "buy," "book online," "learn more," "call," or "visit." Utilizing these CTAs offers users the chance to act after reading the post.
